MASSSES AND FUNERALS 9th May 2025

The archbishop has sent a letter to Clergy and funeral teams. Of course it is relevant to everybody. He refers to his pastoral letter of November 2023 '*Servants of hope: Ministry to the bereaved in a Time of Change*'. Sometimes it's obvious that a particular family who have been bereaved has been away from Church for a significant period! Pastoral care is important to everyone who is bereaved. But this may not be a Funeral Mass. It might be a Funeral Liturgy. Many Parishes have funeral Teams, some are recent, some have been around for a long time. Archbishop Farrell has asked that each Partnership would be able to offer a Funeral Liturgy that isn't Mass. We've a fair bit to do in our Partnership (there are 52 Partnerships in the Diocese) ALSO, the Partnerships have been asked to look at Mass availability/times. It's interesting that because I wanted to attend Fr Dermot's **Months Mind** on the Sunday after Easter, I had to get a priest to do 10.00 and 11.30 Mass as the Months Mind was 10.45.

So, over the next 3 weekends we're looking for opinions on Masses. We met with Bishop Donal before Easter, and he suggested that Sunday evening Mass might be an option. It's very popular in other areas of the Diocese. It would be celebrated in the same Church, but the Priest would be on a Rota. It's not a vote and biggest number gets kept, we're looking for opinions/ideas for masses in our partnership. I am hopeful that we will get a Parish Chaplain between Foxrock and Newtownpark, but not sure for how long. Think about it for a week or so
