## Summer Dues

The Archbishop launched the Summer Dues initiative last month. During Covid the Common Fund (support for Priests in Parishes and Retired, including nursing homes charges) took a bashing and the Summer Dues is its Saviour!!

The envelopes have been distributed, Thanks to all in the Parish Office and those who drop envelopes into doors. As was mentioned recently, in the Parish Financial talk the Summer Dues with Christmas and Easter plus the first Collection at Sun Masses is the support for the Priests. Foxrock always punches above its weight!! If we can capture/trace donations, then we can claim tax for the Parish. It's nearly half again that goes to the Parish. So Common Fund, Family offering, Both Sunday mass collections can be included. For the Accountants among you the amount is 32/68.

The Archbishop says “*The ministerial priesthood has come down to us in the Church from Jesus and the Apostles. Please encourage and pray for your priests in their ministry, and pray, too, for an increase in vocations to the priesthood.
